PLAYING ON HARDCOURTS members

With the exception of Tuesday morning and Saturday and Sunday afternoons, the hardcourts are under the lease of the coaching academy so please note the following information regarding playing on the hardcourts:

If members want to play on the hardcourts there are the following options:

- **A.** During the daylight CASUAL If courts are free during the day, members can play without booking the court. Note that there is a risk of the court being booked online by someone else but during the day hours (before 330pm) this risk is low.
- **B.** During the daylight RESERVE If members want to guarantee a court, they can book it at a 50% discount (\$7.50 per hour)
- **C.** During the evening UNDER LIGHTS Any play under lights must be booked by members who can book it at a 50% discount (\$10 per hour)

FACILITIES REPORT

HARD COURTS

The Committee has arranged for sub surface scanning of courts 1 and 6 to be done, to try to identify the cause of the raised section on court 1 and cracking on courts 5 and 6. We expect to have a report on this in the next few days and will decide on a course of action to have any necessary repairs made.

NEW PATIO

Finally from the City of Stirling, we have a start date for construction of the new patio, however, it's now booked for October, so hopefully and fingers crossed it will be ready for Opening Day of next season. The Committee is looking at options to partially enclose the patio once it has been built, to reduce the impact of sun and weather on members. The Committee is also considering the practicality and merits of fully covering and paving the patio opposite court 5, to give a larger, weatherproof area.

COURT SURROUNDS

Quotes are being sought to remove all the shrubs and plants on the inside of the boundary fencing, as their only purpose seems to be as an annual Busy Bee task and ongoing ball catchers. The 2 trees outside court 11 will be trimmed in time for the start of next season. Thanks to Steve Jones, Gaye and Di for their help with removing and treating the retaining wall plants. The City of Stirling has been contacted for its assistance in backfilling the areas where sand has been washed from the walls.
