CHAIRMANS REPORT

MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

The new season is upon us fast and membership renewals and the new membership drive is well under way.

As many of you are aware – we are continuing our incentive to build new growth at the club and to continue this upward trend by incentivising the first years fees for new members with a 40% discount and a 20% discount to returning members who haven't been with us in 2022/2023.

Last season our club membership increased by 15% and we are seeking to surpass this amount for the coming season. New members increase participation across all social and competition tennis at the club and make a big difference in our planned social activities off the court. Currently we have around 243 members from Juniors through to Seniors and our aim in the next two seasons is to achieve more than 300+ members.

It is vital that we continue this practice to ensure the clubs financial stability and it allows us to look forward and plan on how better we can make the facilities and participation better for all members.

As an FYI - Our new signage will be going up soon to further assist the membership and court hire utilising unique QR codes to pass on key information to members and potential members.

STRATEGIC PLAN

We have created a small sub committee to assist myself in working on the new Strategic Plan for the Club and we are looking at having this completed in the next 8 weeks or so.

This process has been on the table for more than a decade with various Committees and never seems to have reached the finish line so this is our mandate! Reach the finish line!

What is a Strategic Plan? It is a working document that outlines the short and long terms goals and objectives on how the club wants to operate and grow. In essence it is very simplistic in nature, but very important in the long run, ensuring continuity and sameness as no doubt there will be changes within the members of the Committee over the coming years.

We will await further updates from the team to how the club can progress in to having an updated and license since the renovation and with the potential of more trading hours - fingers crossed. FACILITIES REPORT

HARD COURTS

The City of Stirling has been contacted about damage to courts 1, 5 and 6 and will be conducting an inspection this week, with findings available shortly after and action taken as soon as possible after this.

KEY ACCESS

Locks have been placed on the front entry gate, and gates to the deck and grass courts 7, 11 and 19. The code for the main entry is 3112, with the other locks being 2512. Please lock and scramble the code if you're the last one to leave.

PATIO

We don't yet have a start date for construction of the new patio, however, work is now not expected to start until September and should take about 4-5 weeks, so unfortunately isn't likely to be ready in time for Opening Day on October 7th. The partial enclosing of the patio will be undertaken as soon as possible after the patio is built. See proposed plans at the rear of this Newsletter.

COURT SURROUNDS

All the shrubs and plants on the inside of the boundary fencing will be removed next month, as their only purpose seems to be as an annual Busy Bee task and ongoing ball catchers. The 2 trees outside court 11 will also be trimmed to allow sunlight to fall on the courts as the growing season starts. As you may have noticed, a large section of boundary fencing along Manning Road was damaged during the storm on August 3rd. Thanks to the City of Stirling for arranging urgent temporary bracing as the fence was a hazard. Permanent repairs are expected to be carried out shortly.





Site Plan & Elevations - Proposed Patio Scarborough Tennis Club 101-105 Denmore Rd Scarborough


