DUTY ROSTER

As mentioned in the September Newsletter we will be trialling a Social Supervisor on the roster calendar, to take some of the workload off the committee.

If you're down for Social Supervisor and in most cases rostered on sets as well, can you please find out from a committee person (if you don't know) how the key system works, as it's your responsibility to open up. Also, if you are on Bar Duty you need to know how the key system works as it will be your responsibility to lock up.

BALL ROTATION

With some feedback about the ball rotation the following process will apply-

If new balls are put out on a Saturday, they will be used for Saturday & Sunday.

Then new balls will be put out on Tuesday & used for Tuesday & Saturday.

Then new balls will be put out on Sunday and used for Sunday & Tuesday, and so on.

There will be other variables on this, like twilight tennis, rain days and opening 8 courts of balls one day and only having 3 courts the next time.

This system will only require the use of one ball container allowing less clutter in the captain's room and stop prolong exposure after opening.

The committee will be making the decision on the rotation.

\$10 non- members BBQ only.



FACILITIES REPORT

HARD COURTS

Engineers were checking out the culvert underneath the hard courts last week, and it appears that there are a few places where the concrete lid may have collapsed. they are working their way through the blockages, but it is likely that we wont know the full extent until next month. Once this is known, they will work put a course of action to carry out repairs.

PATIO

The City of Stirling is still considering the best way forward, as there is an issue with the proximety of the nearest fore hydrant to the club. At this stage, it looks as the the patio will not be installed until the end of the season. As a temporary measure, second hand retractable blinds are being installed to cut out the worst of the wind, sun and rain. Yes, they are a bit ratty, but it's the cheapest way to give us some protection.

COURT USAGE

A reminder to members that, outside penannts, single play is only to be carried out on the top bay. This is to allow more time for the lower courts to recover, particulary courts 7-9 and 12-14 which are shorter and have less capacity for the baselines to be moved.
