## FACILITIES REPORT

#### HARD COURT LIGHTING

We have selected an electrician to install the new LED lights, and a date will be set shortly for them to be installed. The new lights will lead to significantly better playing conditions. There may be some disruption to night play as they are installed, but this will be kept to a minimum. At the same time that the LEDs are installed, we'll be adding a speaker outside the Pro Shop for music and announcements.

### **CLUBROOMS UPGRADE**

While the bulk of the work on the clubrooms upgrade has been completed, there are a few outstanding items still to be completed by the builder, and we expect these to be finished shortly. We're in discussions with the City of Stirling to re-locate the boundary fencing closer to the clubrooms, and hope to have this done in January.


