FACILITIES REPORT

The old metal halide hard court lights have been replaced with bright LEDs. There will be some tweaking over the next week to get the maximum benefit from them, but the lights are a definite improvement.

The hard court surface itself is nearing the end of its life, and the Committee is looking at renewing the courts in the next couple of years.

The cyclone mesh fencing along the lower bay retaining wall will be completed by Australia Day, and I expect that the top bay wall will be done during February. Vegetation on the walls will also be poisoned/removed on a regular basis and this should avoid the need for people to scramble up the walls to retrieve stuck balls

Despite problems with the reticulation over the Christmas/New Year period, the courts are in excellent condition and my thanks go out to Brad and his team for their hard work.

The City of Stirling has advised that all outstanding upgrade work on the clubrooms should be completed by the end of January, and with Western Power repairing the electrical system on the 21st, we'll have full use of all appliances and air conditioners.

I encourage members to volunteer some time to help with the Odd Jobs list on the noticeboard, so that we can maintain our clubrooms and surrounds in the best possible condition.

These will also serve as our mandatory enclosed are for adhering to our liquor license agreement. The small fence and gate at the rubbish bin area will also be replaced at the same time.


SOCIAL COORDINATOR
